While the film is set in Southern Iraq, we will hold the casting and rehearsal sessions in Baghdad. We have already approached top talents in Iraq, who are willing to support the project and work within our financial means. In addition to leading talents, we will work directly with real students, farmers, and women living in Southern Iraq, so our supporting roles and background characters will be authentic to the Southern, rural setting. It is our utmost goal to ensure that everyday women of Iraq see themselves reflected in the character of Dunia, as well as the young women she hopes to rescue.



DUNIA

A 38-year-old mother used to taking care of her daughter, husband and the house obsessively. Even though she is a good mother who loves her family, she feels trapped in the house. As a teenager she struggled finding a way to go to high school, or a way to study abroad. After these struggles, her hopes of going abroad vanished, and she shifted her focus to marriage. Because she lived in an environment which believes the sooner a woman gets married the better, she feared the community might view her as a spinster. Being a spinster or getting a divorce are the worst things that could happen to a woman in her society, especially in the South of Iraq. So, she got married when she was around twenty. After getting married, she thought life would be much better than being within her parents, but she soon realized she would never have any time for herself. Now, she struggles to find meaning for her life.





THE PRODUCER



Clare Fog is a producer originally from the USA, currently working in Portugal. She received an M.A. in Film Producing from Kinoeyes European Movie Masters, a consortium between Lusofona Universidade in Portugal, Screen Academy Scotland, and Baltic Film & Media School. In 2017, she completed three short films currently submitted to the festival circuit for 2018. These include the Estonian drama shorts Jahiloom (Wild Game) and Unejutud (Vladimir), as well as Scottish action film Wicked Tongue. For her projects currently in development, she received the Golden Panda Vancouver International Film Festival - Creative Spark Award for her feature film pitch Lianas (Vines), a feature thriller film set in Colombia. Her script was a Quarter Finalist for the Screencraft Film Fund. Her feature length animation film A Grande Onda has received development support from the Portuguese Institute of Cinema and Audiovisuals (ICA) and is currently produced in partnership with Sardinhas Em Lata Animation Studio.

Prior to her short films, she debuted on the American independent producing scene in 2011 with her feature film *Improvising*, which won the Vanguard Best Breakthrough Director Award and Audience Choice Nomination at the Independent Filmmakers Showcase in Los Angeles. She is also the founder of Clear Fog Films, LLC.




